International Parachute jump operation. Pribram/CZ, 17-19 September 2010



Operation Eastern Wings

Place: Pribram/Czech Republic.

Dates: 17-19 September 2010.

Registration Deadline: 30 days prior the start of the event

Participants: Beginners and experienced.

No of participants: Minimum 10.

Offer: Two (2) nights hotel accomodation (meals not included but available for about 15,00 Euro per day at the airfield restaurant); Theoretical and practical pre-jump training (you will receive classroom instruction and practical ground training in the principles of military parachuting, exit-position, behaviour below the parachute, malfunctions, safety procedures, emergency landings, PLF, etc. in reference to the military standards); Use of all necessary parachute equipments; Parachute jumps (3 static line jumps) with OVP-68 military round canopy (steering-gear) out Antonov AN-2 airplane; Czech parachutist badge with certificate; European parachutist badge with certificate; wings-awarding-ceremony.

Price: € 360,00

Additional offer: During the event it will be possible to gain the Slovak, Polish, Ukrainian and Russian wings. To gain an additional wing-set 1 jump of the 3 done are counted for the award. (Each additional wings award: 120,00 Euro).

Optional jumps: Extra jumps are possible on extra charge of 60,00 Euro. Tactical jumps (with equipment) and freefall jumps are possible on extra charge.

Beginners Course: During the event it will be possible to attend the Beginners Training Course on extra charge of 50,00 Euro.

Schedule (changes are possible):

Day 1: Arrival; Start of the Operation; Classroom instruction and practical ground training; Free Time.

Day 2: Airborne training (Jumps); Free Time.

Day 3: Airborne training (Jumps); Wings Awarding Ceremony; End of Program; Departure.

Equipment: Field uniform, jump-boots and jump-helmet.

Requirements: Parachute Licence; Jump insurance; Medical certificate for jumping (You must bring this documents with you).

Meeting points:

- Pibram Airfield, Day 1 at 13:00 h. (Directions will be provided to the participant).
- Prague Airport, Day 1 at 11:00 h. (Transfers from airport to the airfield and return is available for extra charge on place).

Arrangements: Contact us for arrangements and scheduling if you have a group of 10 or more interested individuals. Special arrangements, such as group airfares, tour extensions, or special interest sightseeing may be arranged.

Registration and Payment: You have to register and pay the course fee, no later than the registration deadline.
